

Cambodia Millennium Development Goals



At the United Nations Millennium Summit held in September 2000 in New York, the United Nations Millennium Declaration was adopted. The Millennium Declaration is a landmark document for the new century, which reflects the concerns of the heads of State and Government and the nations who participated in the largest-ever gathering of world leaders. At the Summit, all the participating UN Member States have pledged to achieve by 2015 the following goals with specific targets:

| Goal 1: Eradicate extreme poverty and hunger | Target 1: Halve, between 1993 and 2015, the proportion of people whose income is less than the national poverty line Target 2: Halve, between 1993 and 2015, the proportion of people who suffer from hunger |

| Goal 5: Improve maternal health | Target 10: Improve maternal health |
| Goal 6: Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria and other diseases | Target 11: Decrease the spread of HIV/AIDS Target 12: Decrease the incidence of malaria, dengue fever and TB |
| Goal 7: Ensure environmental sustainability | Target 13: Integrate the principles of sustainable development into country policies and programmes and reverse the loss of environmental resources Target 14: Halve by 2015 the proportion of people without sustainable access to safe drinking water Target 15: Halve by 2015 the proportion of people without access to improved sanitation Target 16: Increase the proportion of the population in both urban and rural areas with access to land security by 2015 |
| Goal 8: Forge a global partnership for development | Localized targets and indicators yet to be set |
| Goal 9: Move towards zero victims and a country without mines | Target 17: Moving towards zero impact from landmines and UXOs by 2012 Target 18: Eliminate the negative humanitarian and socio-economic impacts of landmines and UXOs by 2025 |

The first localised Cambodia Millennium Development Goals Report is being finalized and will be launched in early 2004. It comprises the process of adapting and tailoring the goals to the socio-economic context of the country and its development priorities.
